Booking Your Dialysis Online (The Renal Traveller Way)

- **Search & Request:** Find verified clinics on the app.
- **Secure Upload:** Send medical reports and serology via the app.
- **Monitor Status:** Check app notifications for “Booking Accepted.”
- **Save the Details:** Screenshot your dialysis booking confirmation.



Medical Documentation (The “Must-Haves”)

- **Viral Serology:** Recent results and vaccination card.
- **Medical Prescription:** In English, including treatment details.
- **Medication List:** Bring a printed backup.
- **Insurance / Payment:** Check coverage or be prepared to pay.
- **Transplant Centre Notification:** Provide your holiday address if you are on the transplant waiting list.



Packing Essentials (Carry-On Only)

- **Critical Medications:** Keep in your carry-on with medical certificate.
- **Comfort Kit:** Headphones, blanket, snacks.
- **Fistula Protection:** Wear loose clothing and avoid carrying heavy bags.
- **Hygiene & Emergency Kit:** Disinfectant, bandages, face masks, and important documents.



For PD Patients (Peritoneal Dialysis)

- **Individual Supplies:** Bring your essential PD materials (e.g., dressings/plasters)
- **Cycler Device:** Notify the airline 48 hours before travel.
- **Heating Solution:** Pack a thermal bag if required.
